

DATE CHANGE: NxLevel Start-Up Course Being Offered in Peoria

PEORIA, AZ (March 2011) – Peoria will host an 11-week program called NxLevel Start-Up beginning in **April 13, 2011**. Offered in partnership with the MCC Small Business Development Center (SBDC), the course will meet Wednesdays from 4:00- 7:00 p.m.

NxLevel™ Business Start-ups course is an 11-session course designed for people who want to start a business and need the skills to test the feasibility of their business concept. Participants develop a business plan which acts as the blueprint for their start-up venture. Upon successful completion of the course, the participant will learn the following: • What it takes to be a successful entrepreneur • How to develop and test their business concept • How to select the best business entry option • How to organize and manage their business • How to research and market their business • How to understand and get their financials in order • How and where to get funding for their business • How to determine feasibility of their business concept • How to develop a network with other entrepreneurs

The fee for this course is \$150 to cover the cost of materials and offers three college credits. The classes will be held in the DCSB Bldg. located at 9875 N. 85th Ave, Peoria AZ 85345.
